

## **Public Notice**

Notice is hereby given that the Municipal Authority of the Township of South Fayette has prepared an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Special Study for interceptor capacity upgrades in the Millers Run interceptor sewershed in order to bring the system into compliance with the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law and the Federal Clean Water Act. The projects will provide wet weather control and accommodate future growth within sewershed to abate critical public health hazards resulting from overflows of untreated sewage. The proposed alternatives include a series of parallel and replacement sewers ranging in size from 15-inch to 24-inch in the Cuddy Lane area and along Millers Run Road from the District Magistrate to the I-79 interchange. The estimated cost of the Phase 1 project is \$1.5 million. The Authority intends to secure a 10-year bank note to fund the Phase 1 project. The anticipated effective monthly user rates are anticipated to increase from \$50.00 in 2016 to \$66.95 by 2020 including anticipated increases in ALCOSAN's monthly charges.
